



## **Complementary agreement to the 'Promotionsvereinbarung' of TU Berlin and the 'Rules for Doctoral Research at the IGB' for doctoral students of the DFG Research Training Group Urban Water Interfaces (UWI)**

1. Progress of the dissertation is to be discussed at least once every six months between the doctoral student and the designated Board of Supervisors (BoS). The first meeting will be part of the exposé talk about three months after starting the dissertation. One of the six-month meetings will be held during the annual UWI workshop. The other meetings will be initiated by the doctoral student. Short minutes of all meetings (max. 1 page) will be prepared by the doctoral student and circulated to the BoS for approval.
2. The supervisors agree to be available for short-term appointments upon request by the doctoral student.
3. The doctoral student must attend various courses (core and elective courses) and workshops in agreement with the qualification concept of the UWI Research Training Group. According to the European Credit Transfer System (ECTS), the doctoral student must obtain at least 18 ECTS in course and/or comparable work.
4. In addition, the doctoral students are expected to participate in scientific events organized by UWI or their home institutions, departments and working groups (e.g. UWI workshops, Colloquium Hydrosciences, IGB Colloquium, other seminars).
5. The doctoral student, assisted by the BoS, makes a special effort to complete the doctoral thesis within 3 years.
